

I Am Redeemed

To say that man's redemption is at stake is an understatement. Mankind refused Jesus Christ when he was on earth, they refused him when God raised him from the dead, and they continue to refuse his works today. The spiritual battle that rages against Christians purposefully clouds the skies of redemption. Psalms 34: 22 The Lord redeemeth the soul of his servants: and none of them that trust in him shall be desolate.

from Adam's curse and it can never again be used against you.

Romans 5:18 Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life.

The Lord Jehovah, one of the redemptive names of God, is in the business of redemption. He sent His son, Jesus Christ, in order that you would be redeemed. Your redemption runs deeply through the works of Christ. Christ redeemed mankind from

Adam's curse, and he also redeemed mankind from the curse of the law.

Galatians 3: 13 Christ hath **redeemed** us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed *is* every one that hangeth on a tree:

The curse was removed because Christ became a curse by dying on that tree. Without this legal redemption, Christian sonship could never have taken place. The nature of the spiritual battle required absolute legality.

Galatians 4: 5 To **redeem** them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption [sonship – adoption is an incorrect translation] of sons.

First, Jesus Christ redeemed Israel from the curse of the law. Then it became possible to receive sonship as Chris-

tians, born-again ones. The redemption that we have in Christ is not partial redemption.

Titus 2: 14 Who gave himself for us, that he might **redeem** us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

Our redemption is totally complete. Not only is it totally complete, it can never be undone. He redeemed us from all iniquity. All iniquity encompasses every form ever conceived and assaulted against us by satan. It includes iniquity of old. It includes iniquity of more recent years, and it includes iniquities you yourself committed this week. You have been redeemed with no holds barred.

I Peter 1: 18 Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not **redeemed** with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation [way of life] *received* by tradition from your fathers; 19 But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and

without spot:

Man made redemption is corruptible. In other words, any redeeming vices you can conceive, contrive, or otherwise make up could never redeem you from what the devil did with Adam and Eve. Only by the precious blood of Christ was the price paid. So, your redemption is not based on what you could do. It is based on what Christ did and specifically the price he paid with his blood. His blood cleansed you totally and completely and removed all former and future stains of iniquity. What a wonderful, fantastic truth to behold!

If you have ears to hear and hearts to believe, you can start singing a new song about your redemption.

Revelation 5: 9 And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast **redeemed** us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation; 10 And hast made us unto our God

kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.

Christ's redemptive actions make you regal, not regal in the world's sense, but regal in God's. His redemption allows you to reign now, in this life, in the midst of the many spiritual battles in which you become engaged. Accept this perfect redemption and reign as a king today—if you want to be a Super Christian Conqueror.
