October 2021 – SIT Proof – Acquilla and Pricilla

The Fifth Record of speaking in tongues takes place in Acts 19 where we will be introduced to Apollos, the golden tongued orator, and Acquilla and Pricilla.

November 2021 – Benefits of the Manifestations

As regards the manifestations of holy spirit, there are only three Bible chapters that completely detail their usage and the operation. Yet, these three chapters primarily discuss the first three manifestations. Most people have arrested a single chapter from these three chapters, but all three chapters comprise a complete set. If we pull out one, we dismiss



God's intended impact. I am referring to 1 Corinthians 12-14. It is chapter 13 that people often laud, while dismissing 12 and 14. We, in no way, want to diminish their unique relationship.

December 2021 – Unique Greek Words

1 Cor 12:8 KJV Starting with verse eight, we will study the in depth accuracy of the word 'another.' 'Another' comes from one of two Greek words: allos or heteros. Allos means 'another when two or more of the same kind are involved.' Heteros means 'another when only two are in-

involved.' In this case, the two are God and the believer. 'Another' can be translated 'other' depending on the context. Generally, in verses 8-10, the word allos is used.

January 2022 – Charity-Agape Introduction

Perhaps containing the greatest behavioral instructions, 1 Corinthians 13 contains the Bible's most concise expose on how to behave within and without the Family of God. While each of the Gospels and all Church Epistles provide information for how the New Christian Man is to walk, no Christian walk is complete without the overlay of an Agape Code of Conduct.

February 2022 – Charity-Agape Characteristics

Many years ago, I was presented with a perplexing question, not to mention that it was me doing the asking. Regarding the agape characteristics, the question was, "what is kind?"

Honestly, I couldn't answer it. And, neither could a single soul I asked. I ask you, what is kind? If you can't provide a biblical answer, how can you say that you live your life according to agape? You're beginning to understand my dilemma. If I didn't understand one single word, kind, did I understand the others? These, and many other questions, prompted this ongoing study of agape as related to God's Holy Word.

March 2022 – Manifestations in the Church

Christians have been fooled for ages.

(1 Cor 12:1 KJV) Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I would not have you ignorant. Greek New Testament translators saw fit to ignore the proper meaning of pneumatikos, from which 'spiritual gifts' comes. One small word, gifts, has queried the minds of well meaning believers and prevented them from walking into the greatness of a Christ-filled life. Spiritual savy is largely fed by music and dancing, and sadly, far too much emphasis on sentiment. We are to be filled to

overflowing with spirit, not carnal devices. If you want to become a spiritual man or woman, you must listen to Jesus when he taught:

(John 4:24 KJV) God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him

in spirit and in truth.

April 2022 – Usage of the Manifestations

We are studying the subject of the usage of the manifestations of holy spirit, beginning with speaking in tongues with interpretation.

May 2022 – Manifestations Usage - Prophecy

We've spent a lot of time addressing the need for 'a word of prophecy' in the church. God has provided specific instructions for how to use this wonderful manifestation.

June 2022 – Intro to Speaking in Tongues

I would like to begin this chapter with a short review. For most, 1 Corinthians

12 is difficult because of how it has been queried throughout the years. I learned its great truths some 45 years ago. I am still amazed at the igno-

and teachers have no excuse; they should have worked God's Word and uncovered the truth you'll soon learn. By learning what I'm about to present, you will not be among them.

Our quest begins with the first characteristic of agape – called suffereth long. Keeping in mind that we are dealing with old English phrases, we have to find out what this really means.

September 2022 – Agape – Kind

November 2022 – Not of Works

No works are requested of us in order to complete God’s perfect plan of redemption. Absolutely none. Now, this does not mean you can live as you fool well please. It means that you are to abide within God’s framework, his plan, which is laid out in his Word in the

7 Church Epistles, among which Ephesians details a spectacular account of grace, faith, gifts of God and the despair of boasting.

December 2022 – The Sword of the Spirit

I’ve always longed for more information on the sword of the spirit. I’ve absorbed the Roman soldier weapon aspect many times over, but generally felt a lack of vital and spiritual information. Let’s quest to discover a few greater meanings behind the sword of the spirit and its application to our more than abundant lives.

January 2023 – The Just Shall Live by Faith

Either we live our Christian life in the first heaven by faith, or we do not.

(Rom 1:17 KJV) For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to

faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith. The Bible is absolutely clear on the subject of faith. We are justified [just as if we hadn’t sinned] because of Christ in us.

February 2023 – Acceptance

Most people long for acceptance, a sense of value. They desire to be included, loved, and approved of as they are, no matter what.

March 2023 – Peace or a Sword

The time is upon us that necessitates a review of Jesus’ prophetic words regarding the family’s involvement with peace or a sword. If you have children, you have a family. If you are a child of someone, you came from a family. It is this family I am speaking of, not the body of Christ family.

April 2023 – With God All Things are Possible

We have all experienced mental prisons. These prisons are wretched and tormenting. For most, no matter what is done, escape seems impossible. The feelings of self-defeat accompanying a lifetime of prison escape attempts are negative, defeating, and most wretched.

May 2023 – How To Be: Part One

Much talk surrounds us regarding whether or not we are in the End Times. Perhaps you wonder if we are? Let’s discuss some ways of viewing the vari-

Verse 1 states that there is no need to write about the times and the seasons related to the day of the Lord. What is the Day of the Lord?

July 2023 – How To Be: Part Three

The Day of Christ Because it is mentioned, I shall define the Day of Christ. It is the gathering together. There are two different events of the return of Christ; the gather-

ing together during this current period of time called *grace*, and Christ's coming with his armies during the upcoming period of time called *tribulation*.

August 2023 – Appreciation – The Sinking Ship

Showing appreciation and being appreciated is vital in the cycle of deliverance. The following will open your understanding of how God delivers no matter how difficult the situation.

September 2023 – Battling Brokenness

Sadly, the nature of brokenness with which we are faced, is generally not healed by zealous biblical study, how many times you visit a religious location, or even the people with whom you associate. To heal brokenness, we must seek mental transformation, precisely that written in Romans 12:2—the renewing of our minds. Since this is true, brokenness is the result of a mental transformation.

October 2023 – Victory in Life

As God's people, let us strive to be victory-minded, a simple concept, a mighty challenge.

November 2023 – Confronting Deceitful Traditions

In a casual but well-known confrontation, scribes and Pharisees questioned Jesus about the tradition of the elders, confronting him and his disciples. This was one of four different confrontations in Matthew 15.

December 2023 – The Truth Shall Make You Free

A most famous Bible verse sets like a diamond in the Gospel of John, chapter 8. You are familiar with it even if you don't think you are – the truth shall make you free. See what I mean? Those words are heard and used the world over for purposes other than what Jesus intended.

January 2024 – Prayer Warriors

The New Testament contains many examples of the Apostle Paul requesting prayers. Today we can learn the importance of praying for Church leadership, and also what we should be praying for.

February 2024 – Inner-Most Feelings – Part One

The Bible has much to say about the soul, how it

works and the value it can bring to people in your life. More specifically, since the soul is the seat of your emotional life, from where your feelings originate, innermost feelings come into play in many Word-centered activities. The Greek word for compassion is splagchnizomai. This word is often translated compassion; it specifically refers to inner-most feelings. The root word, splagkhnōn, means intestine or bowels. Figuratively, it refers to feelings from your gut. You are familiar with phrases like 'gut feel' or 'my deepest feelings'. These and more have their basis in this Greek word.

March 2024 – Inner-Most Feelings – Part Two
Part II continues looking at more usages of this Greek word (splagchnizomai), beginning with compassion that Jesus had for the multitudes.

April 2024 – Dealing with Sadness
How should a Christian manage the emotion of sadness? Often, we may find ourselves tempted with a deluge of heaviness, gloom and sadness, thinking that there is no way out, often resigning to

grieving. Perhaps we can control our outward display of emotions more than we think? Perhaps Jesus taught keys to deliverance from sadness that can reach far into our souls and help us navigate this negative emotional landscape.

May 2024 – Ministering Seed to the Sower
I'd like to share the dynamics of sowing seed, a vital aspect of Christian giving. Our journey begins in the Gospels, Old Testament books that provide the beginning of a doctrinal basis for what was soon to come in the Christian Church. Jesus taught on the importance of giving, not holding back even when tempted to do so. Regarding ministering seed to the sower, the Church believers are asked to sow of their abundance so that their leader, a sower of God's word, has no lack.

June 2024 – Ministering to the Saints
One highly significant Abundant Sharing theme is captured in 2 Corinthians 9. We are taught how active the Corinthian believers were in ministering to the saints.

July 2024 – Be Ready to

Minister

The Macedonian believers' abundant sharing (ABS) habits were so astounding that God chose them to assist Paul. These remarkable people accompanied Paul when he collected ABS from the Corinthians, not only for safety in numbers, but also as a touchstone of truth and action. Let's spend some time in 2 Corinthians 9, verses 3- 6, to understand certain logistics that Paul and the believers underwent.

July 2024 Special Issue – Agape and Abundant Sharing Combined

It is up to us to pray that we can lead a quiet and peaceful life. We are light. As we pray, our light dispels the darkness. Make sure that prayer is on the top of your 'to do' list. Pray that we can lead a quiet and peaceful life. One thing I would like to ask you all to do, and maybe you can do this every day. It is to read 2 Corinthians chapters eight and nine.

August 2024 – Sowing is Ministering

We may never have considered the criticality of sowing with regard to ministering, but sowing is a critical component of min-

istering. Sowing is a direct form of ministering. Without it, there would be no abundant sharing ministering taking place. Never to be disregarded is the truth that we are to sow so that we lay a solid foundation of blessings for self and others.

September 2024 – The Standard of Ministering – Part I

Allow me to transport you to a year in my past—1979. I had just begun my first year of the Way Corps in residence training, a Way Ministry leadership program designed to educate and prepare individuals for the Christian Ministry. One graduation requirement was to write a research paper of scholarly design, a paper that would exhibit the member's research skills, and that would chart a fulfilling course of continued studies and leadership. Needless to say, choosing the topic and writing the initial hypothesis was outrageously daunting. I felt that I didn't know what I was doing; in order to complete the initial requirements, I had only God as my guide. He led me to the subject of abundant sharing and the following verse. (2 Cor 9:7 KJV)

October 2024 – The Standard of Ministering – Part II

Part I of The Standard of Giving ended with me providing a literal of 2 Corinthians 9:7a. Part II will continue with the rest of this verse. The following is a repeat of the closure of Part I's teaching.

November 2024 – The Standard of Ministering – Part III

Parts 1 and 2 covered 2 Corinthians 9:7, except for the last part of verse 7. (2 Cor 9:7 KJV) Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver. This Artios, Part 3, will cover 'for God loveth a cheerful giver.'

December 2024 – Discovering Superabundance

I'd like to offer the following, that 2 Corinthians is the abundance book.

January 2025 – Rise Up – Part I

Throughout the New Testament, we can see references to the concept of rising up, raised, being raised, raised up, raised from, risen, risen again, awake, rose again, rose

from, and rise. All of these usages are translated from the same Greek word - egeiro.

February 2025 – Rise Up – Part II

Continuing from Part I, let's discover what Ephesians 5:14 can teach us about Rising Up. What God did with and for Jesus Christ spanned all three heavens. Jesus breathed real air in the first heaven; he passed through the second heaven, stars, all beings celestial, and arrived at the third heaven, God's home, and Jesus Christ's new home. All of the greatness of God's power was manifested when he raised his son from the dead AND set Jesus Christ at his own right hand in the heaven above the skies, the heaven high above all power and all principalities, essentially, all of God's creation.

March 2025 – Rise Up – Part III

Continuing from Part II, we shall look deeper into Ephesians 5:14. We can see two distinct 'sleep' situations; one physical and one mental. Jesus and Paul confronted the mental. Jesus told us why, because of temptations. We become over-

come with temptations when we become mentally sleepy. The word of God will wake us up and help us through tough times. Also, prayer will help as Jesus admonished. Pray that ye enter not into temptation.

April 2025 – Sons of God

The first time the phrase Sons of God was used in the Bible is in Genesis 6:2. Since this subject is so vital to the family of God's existence, of course there will be tons of controversy. Let's start with this verse and learn more.

May 2025 – Nothing Better than the Word!

Shall we feast!

(Psalm 119:1–11 KJV)

There is nothing more powerful, more awesome, and more delivering than God's Word. God gave us his Word; we are to give him our all.

June 2025 – Forget the Past!

Have you ever wondered about the mechanism of forgetfulness? I'm talking about forgetting things, attempting to forget things, wishing that you could forget things, and the like. God wants us to forget those things which

are behind, and to reach forth to those things that are before. The more we understand the power of forgetfulness, the more aligned we'll be with God's will.

September 2025 – To Desire Safety

Have you ever noticed an internal voice, albeit slight and nagging, begging for safety? That's normal, especially during a crisis. We need to satisfy that need

no matter when it appears; we need to affirm that it is safe. In case you didn't know, that voice is your subconscious talking. What better way to affirm safety than by using God's word. In difficult times, affirm to yourself that safety abounds . . . and tell yourself why.

October 2025 - Healing from Lustful Behaviors

In the Bible, God has cited three specific areas in which sexual lusts ruin a Christian's life. He also provided us with three powerfully-specific methods for dealing with sexual lusts. Romans contains doctrine to every Christian; 2 Timothy contains leadership admonition; 1 Peter contains guidance for fulfilling an agape lifestyle. The three situations in which believers could find themselves trapped by sexual lusts are (1) completely asleep to the topic of lust, (2) still performing youthful lust-pursuits, and (3) contending with carnal inclinations. If any of these apply to you, the solution is single and entire—walk according to the agape Christian Code of Conduct. Let's begin.
